

NCIS Reality Check

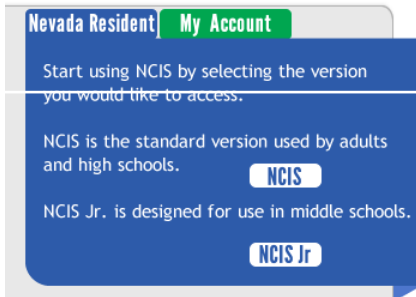
Description

Reality Check is an interactive exploration tool where students indicate the kind of life style they want to live in the areas of housing, food, clothes, transportation, and other items. After deciding how much money they want to spend per month on essential and luxury items, the monthly and annual income requirements needed to maintain that lifestyle are calculated. Then students compare these amounts to projected salaries in their desired work areas.

Administration and Scoring

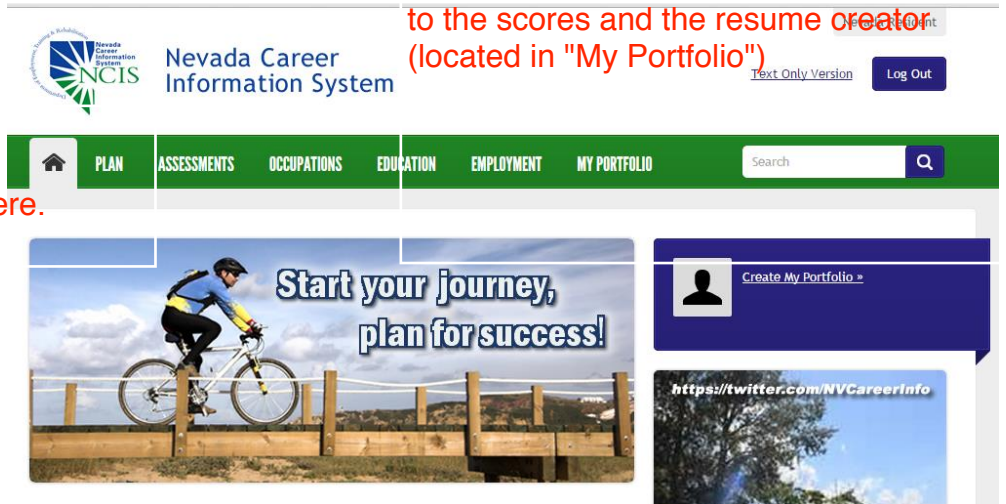
